

## Announcement

Central bank of Syria announces its need for Internal - External tender for the supply and installation of /3/ machines to print, mark and wrap the cheques, also capable of printing **MICR Line** and the rest of cheque`s data for the Central Bank of Syria in Damascus and its branches in the governorates.

**- Bid bond:**

- 1- For local bidder: **200000 SYP** only two hundred thousand Syrian pounds.
- 2- For foreign bidder: **3200 Euros** only three thousand & two hundred Euros.

- **Performance bond:** 10% of the contract`s value.

- **Period of connection of the bidder to his offer:** /90/ days starting from the next day of last appointment for submitting offers.

- **Period of connection of the candidate bidder to his offer:** /90/ days starting from the next day of the date of notifying him in writing the decision of referring the undertaking to him officially.

- **Execution Period:** The period specified for execution of the contract is (100) days, including the delivery of equipment, installation and training starting from the date on which the contractor is duly notified the written commencement order or from the date of notifying the beneficiary the L/C establishment.

And that is according to the books of conditions which can be obtained from the Requirements & Buildings & Contracts Department at the Central Bank of Syria in Damascus during official working hours against a sum of **(2000) SYP only two thousand syrian pounds for local offer & (35) Euros only thirty five Euros for foreign offer** paid in cash to Bank Treasury.
